Please be aware of competition entry closing dates, these are published on the website with the competition dates. If you wish to enter your child you need to send a 'competition entry request' via the contact us page of the R&B website. The new competition structure only allows movement up the grades at the beginning of a new year; competitors will then compete at their level for the remainder of the year. The only exception is at NDP 6 where you must qualify at a regional competition to enter NDP 7 or 8.

Calling all parents, we need your help!

Are you interested in becoming more involved with the club? We are looking for people who are interested in coaching, helping at competitions, and someone to take over looking after the club clothing.

<u>Coaching</u> - Courses are available throughout the year for trampoline level one coaches and the club can part fund the cost of the training. All coaches are required to be British Gymnastics (BG) members, and hold a Safeguarding and Protecting Children (SPC) Certificate. Coaching courses are mostly funded by the club.

<u>Competition officials and marshals</u> - The club is always required to enter officials and marshals when we enter your children into competitions. The more children that enter, the more officials the club has to provide, if you're going anyway... Why not?

<u>Clothing</u> - Barbara Foster has been ordering, and dispensing Ringwood and Bournemouth clothing for a while now, and as her son Alex left for university (3 years ago), she feels it is time to pass on the baton. Double Mini Trampoline (DMT)

Member numbers are looking good for trampoline, but we need more members involved in DMT. DMT is an extension of trampoline, and most of the same skills are applied, you do not have to be able to somersault to take part, and we want you to come and have a go. You can compete DMT on the same day as you do your trampoline competition, so you have two chances of medaling.

It is disruptive to coaching and in turn reduces the quality of the session for that child. Conditioning and stretching is a vital part of a club session; it helps to strengthen specific muscles for trampolining, and ingrains good practice for the future.
